



Understanding your Vision Benefits

The Vision Refresh Plan provides a comprehensive eye health exam. Plus, you receive benefits for either glasses or contacts. Here's an overview of the Vision Refresh plan's benefits with providers in the Vision Refresh network. Out-of-network benefits are also available.

- **Eye exam** – You pay a \$10 copayment for an eye exam
- **Glasses** – You receive wholesale pricing on frames, plus coverage for prescription lenses (single, bifocal, trifocal, lenticular) with a materials copayment of \$15. The materials copayment applies to lenses, frames or a complete set of eyewear. In addition, you receive fixed pricing on popular lens options, including anti-reflective and scratch-resistant coatings.
- **Contact lens** – If you prefer contacts, a \$200 allowance is available, following the \$15 copayment. The contact lens allowance applies to professional services (evaluation and fitting fee) and materials. Medically necessary contacts are paid in full following the \$15 copayment for prescription lenses.
- **Lasik Services**- Participating independent laser centers provide a 10% discount

⇒ **Frame Benefit**– Covers glasses, in full, that are valued at up to \$50 wholesale or approximately \$135 retail.

The Retail cost of \$135 is the average cost that equates to \$50 wholesale, but it does vary slightly between providers.
